Here is sample bequest language that you might like to share with your estate lawyer for possible inclusion:

### **Sample Bequest Language:**

I, give, devise and bequeath to War Child Canada the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of War Child Canada.

I give, devise and bequeath to War Child Canada \_\_\_\_\_ percentage of the residue of my estate to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of War Child Canada.

Upon the death of the survivor of my (wife, husband, etc.,) \_\_\_\_\_ and my (son, daughter, etc.,) \_\_\_\_\_, I direct my trustee to transfer and deliver the balance of the residue of my estate, including any undistributed income to War Child Canada to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of War Child Canada.

### **Sample Wording for Legacy Gift to Benefit War Child Canada in Perpetuity:**

I give War Child Canada \_\_\_\_\_ (state share, or percentage of estate or specific amount). I direct this money to be invested and the income generated be used to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of War Child Canada.
